

NOTICE OF RATE INCREASE

Five Nineteen, LLC, dba Fresh Tracks Transportation and/or Ride Taxi filed Passenger Tariff, Colorado PUC No. 1 with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission on August 18, 2022. The proposed effective date of the tariff is September 19, 2022.

Ride Taxi is authorized by Certificate 55868 to transport passengers in taxi service between all points with 30-mile radius of the intersection of Hurd Lane and Avon Road in Avon, and from these points to all points in Colorado.

Ride Taxi in Passenger Tariff, Colorado PUC No. 1 proposes to increase the fares for the taxi services authorized by Certificate 58686.

The increased fares are:

	Existing	Proposed
Entry	\$3.45	\$4.00
Each 1/10 of a mile	\$0.35	\$0.40
First mile	\$6.60	\$7.60
Each additional mile	\$3.50	\$4.00
Each additional passenger	\$0.75	\$1.00
Additional luggage	\$0.75	\$1.00

The fare increases in Passenger Tariff, Colorado PUC No. 1 will become effective September 23, 2022, unless the Colorado Public Utilities Commission suspends the effective date of the proposed changes.

Objections to the proposed tariff changes may be mailed to the Colorado Public Utilities Commission, 1560 Broadway, Suite 250, Denver, CO 80202 or e-filed in Proceeding 22AL-0367TR. Any objection to the proposed tariff changes must be received by September 21, 2022.

If the Commission suspends the effective date of the proposed changes and sets the matter for hearing, the filing of a written objection will not by itself allow a person to participate in the hearing.

To participate in the hearing, a party must also file a written intervention and receive leave of the Commission to intervene. Requests to intervene as a party must comply with Commission rules.
